A wind farm in Northern China is contributing to the further development of renewable energy generation, mitigating climate change and the country's dependence on fossil fuels.

Location



The wind energy project is located in Northern China's Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region.

Project



The project consists of 39 wind turbines with a total installed capacity of about 50 MW, generating about 100 GWh annually.

Apart from carbon reduction, the project brought several benefits to the local population: During construction as well as for maintenance, several jobs have been created, and the regional economy in general has benefitted from the procurement of services and equipment.
