Project



This project is a new, green field 469 MW Natural Gas fired combined cycle power plant. The project uses low-emission natural gas instead of coal and other dirty fuels for power generation. Thus, the project activity will avoid significant emission compared to the usual practice in the Indian power sector.

Apart from bringing climate benefits, the project is also supporting sustainable development in the region. Among other activities, the project owner donated several new medical ambulances to the National Rural Health Mission.
