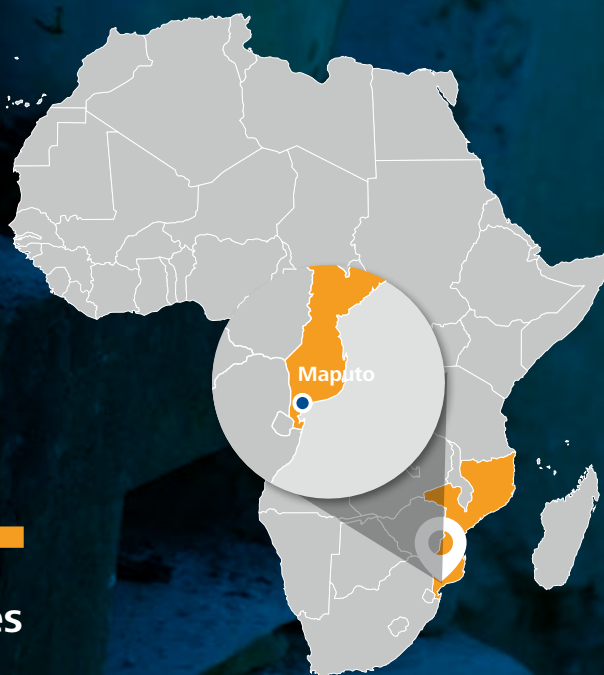




MAPUTO COOKSTOVES MOZAMBIQUE

**Making a difference with clean cookstoves
in Mozambique**



The Maputo Cookstoves Project has distributed approximately 5,000 clean cookstoves to households within Mozambique's capital. By making these fuel-efficient stoves affordable and accessible, households can benefit from reduced indoor air pollution and time and cost savings.



A large population in Maputo, the capital of Mozambique, live in poor housing and hygienic conditions due to a lack of basic services. About 95% of the population in the Chamanculo C district of Maputo uses cookstoves that require high amounts of charcoal for daily cooking activities.

The project has distributed 5,000 Envirofit cookstoves to families living in Maputo. This model is one of the world's most fuel-efficient cookstoves and reduces fuel consumption by up to 50%. Using the efficient stoves reduces indoor air pollution, limits respiratory and eye diseases, and saves families up to 190 US Dollar of fuel costs yearly.

On average, the project prevents 9,332 tonnes of emissions from being released into the atmosphere each year.
