Through our majority-owned subsidiary Climate Friendly and our local joint venture Natural Carbon, we partner with land and native title holders to develop carbon farming projects that unlock economic, social and environmental value through improved management of Australia's land. Combined, Climate Friendly and Natural Carbon have a portfolio of around 100 projects registered under Australia's Emissions Reduction Fund, with around one quarter of the \$2.55 billion ERF under their portfolio management. This includes land-based projects across a wide range of methods, land types, land tenures, and geographies. South Pole supports this work by assisting with project mapping, carbon abatement estimates and project reporting.
